Tara Learning Center: Parent/Student Participation Agreement

We hereby agree to comply with the following rules and policies of Tara Learning Center (TLC):

School closings/cancellations. For school closings, cancellations, and delayed openings due to inclement weather, TLC generally follows *Loudoun County Public School* policy. For complete information regarding our inclement weather policy, see our website posting (<http://www.taralearningcenter.com/closings-and-delays.html>). All TLC families should check *both* local news media, as well as their email, on any day(s) when the weather situation is questionable.

Punctuality. Students/parents agree to be on time for classes. Students who will be late due to traffic or for other reasons should contact either the teacher or the TLC office prior to being late.

Attire. Modest apparel is expected for both guys and girls. Inappropriate dress will not be accepted. Further details regarding our dress code are available online (<http://www.taralearningcenter.com/facility-usedress-code.html>).

Cell phones. Cell phones may be carried by students for emergency use only. We encourage our students to be responsible; phone calls for lunches, homework, etc., that were left at home are discouraged. Electronic devices are only allowed to be used in class if they are being used for that class (i.e. looking up a bookmarked passage for a literature class). Texting and use for entertainment purposes are strictly prohibited.

Study Hall. Study Hall is a designated area where students may work quietly before or after classes. Students may study and work on homework while waiting for a sibling, for their next class, or for their parents to pick them up. If students want to study with each other, they should do so quietly in the front office, in the stairwell, or on the front porch. If a student is persistently disruptive, his or her Study Hall privileges will be revoked.

Behavior. Students are not permitted to be rough with the furniture, sit on tables, lean back in chairs, or throw trash.

Homework. Students are expected to complete all homework assigned. If a student misses a class, the student is expected to contact the teacher for assignments. If class assignments remain uncompleted, then the teacher may request that the student be removed from the class roster, and no refund will be given.

Cheating/plagiarism. Cheating will not be tolerated and may result in dismissal from TLC, and no refund will be given. Copying information from the internet without proper documentation is plagiarism and is considered cheating.

Payment policy/purchase of required books and materials. The tuition fee for each course (except World Literature) is \$200 per semester (\$400/course/year) or, if paying a one-time annual fee, \$375/course/year. (The tuition for World Literature is \$100/semester and \$175/year).

Note that a 20% tuition discount will be applied for families enrolling students in three or more total courses per family. Paying once annually (rather than by semester) affords additional savings (\$25/course).
